## Obtaining a range permit

## Dear Applicant:

Per your request, you will find enclosed the forms for obtaining an access permit for the Barry M. Goldwater Range and the Cabeza Prieta National Wildlife Refuge (Range/Refuge). The following simple directions will assist you in completing those forms.

- 1. Please read carefully the hold harmless agreement and then INITIAL, not check, the nine warning statements.
- 2. Fill out the name, address, phone numbers, and drivers license information as requested. Be sure to date and sign your name on the appropriate line.
- 3. You will need to fill in your name, date, and signature a second time certifying that you have read and understand the hold harmless agreement.
- 4. Return the hold harmless agreement to the issuing agency. If you are applying by mail, it will be necessary to include a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- 5. You will then receive a copy of the range regulations, a map of the area, and two "APPROVED" permit cards. Your permit cards are not valid unless stamped by the issuing agency. These cards will then authorize you to access those areas of the Barry M. Goldwater Range which are open to the public. Please note that you are required to have the permit card on your person and present it to an authorized officer upon demand. If you should leave your vehicle unattended, you must place the second permit card in the window of your vehicle for easy identification.
- 6. ONCE YOU HAVE OBTAINED YOUR RANGE PERMIT, YOU ARE REQUIRED TO CALL TOLL-FREE 1-877-CAMP-010 (1-877-226-7010) PRIOR TO EACH TIME YOU ACCESS THE RANGE/REFUGE. THIS NUMBER IS AVAILABLE 24 HOURS A DAY, 7 DAYS A WEEK. YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE THE PERMIT NUMBERS OF ALL MEMBERS OF YOUR PARTY, THE AREAS YOU PLAN TO VISIT, THE DATE AND DURATION OF YOUR VISIT, AND THE MAKE/MODEL OF ALL VEHICLES USED. The issuing agencies cannot accept Range access calls nor can the toll-free service provide information regarding the obtaining of Range permits.
